BANDOLERO DIVISIONS

YOUNG GUNS

BANDOLERO BULLS

Trophy dash winner Andre Prescott (#80) and Jeremy Birch (#19) played cat and mouse for much of the Main Event, with Prescott edging out Birch for the win. Newcomer Blake Leuth(#12) finished third. Another Speedway Newcomer Houston Franco (#03) triumphed in the heat race.

I-4/I-6 DIVISION

Fastest qualifier Tom Morley(#18) won decisively over Rick Bronson(#35) and Jeffery Goddard (#93) in the Round III Main Event. Earlier in the evening, the Rungaitis Brothers tag teamed their way to victory with Bryan(#9) winning the Trophy Dash while Shane (#15) took the Heat Race.

SUPERSPORTSMAN DIVISION

Kenny Kranzler, in his #14 Camaro, had his first Main Event win at the Speedway, besting another up and coming racer Alex Anderson (#77) followed by John Penning (#30) who finished third after winning two races earlier in the evening. A disappointed Chris Peedan (#98) finished 10th after mechanical issues kept him off his familiar podium perch. Congratulations go to Kenny Kranzler, for Saturday's Trifecta combo, winning in the Trophy Dash, Heat Race and Main Event.

LEGENDS DIVISION

Excitement was the key word in this session's Legends action. Austin Murphy (#07) and Art Nevill (#15) pushed each other throughout the forty-lap main event. Half-way through, Nevill was involved in a spin-out with the #65 car, driven by Race Director, Bob Kindoll, but Nevill still managed to recover to finish third.
