BANDOLEROS DIVISIONS

BANDITS

The Bando Bandits started out the evening's racing with a strong showing from Jack Madrid (#91), sponsored by Fatburger and SignPros. Madrid ran the fastest qualifying time, then took the victory in the trophy dash, and finished off the night by winning the main event. Andre Prescott (#80) of LaQuinta, Ca. was runner up in the main event followed by Tyler Fabozzi (#6) of Anaheim, Ca.

YOUNG GUNS

The Bandolero Young Guns racing night was a carbon copy of the Bandits with one young racer making a clean sweep of the nights action. Andrew Anderson (#4) of Quartz Hill, Ca. had the fastest qualifying time, triumphed in the trophy dash and took the checkered flag in the main event. Jimmy Rouse Jr. (#9) of San Bernardino, Ca. took second, followed closely by Ryan Bragdon (#3) of Beaumont, Ca. in third.

LEGENDS

In Legends, eleven drivers came out to do battle. Young local racer, Austin Murphy (#07) of Lancaster, Ca. set the pace by posting the fastest qualifying time. The trophy dash was won by Art Nevill (#15) of Acton, Ca. after a flagging incident that saw the checkered flag thrown a lap too late. The drivers involved stated, "We race to the checkered regardless." Good sportsmanship like this is not seen very often. Hats are off to these drivers.

In the main event, three racers dominated. Ryan Schug (#34) of Oak Hills, Ca. led for the first eight laps of the thirty lap main until a mechanical problem took him out of the race. That opened the door for 2005 SWS Legend Champ, Art Nevill, to take the lead for eight more laps. Then it was young Austin Murphy (#07) of Lancaster) turn to wrestle the lead away from Nevill. The two racer fought for the rest of the race, but Murphy managed to pull off the win in the end.

SUPER SPORTSMAN DIVISION

The Super Sportsman class had some new faces making impressive moves but it was the crafty veterans who won in the end. Alex Anderson (#77) of Rosamond, Ca. had the fastest qualifying time of the evening. This young man seems to be getting better and better every week. In the trophy dash, current points leader Kenny Kranzler (#14) of Simi Valley, Ca took the win.

Randy Wilkins (#05) of Lancaster, Ca. led a tight field for the first ten laps of the main event. On lap number eleven, 2004 Speedway class champion, Chris Peedan (#98) of Palmdale, Ca. took the lead and held onto it. Alex Anderson (#77) of Rosamond, Ca. finished second with John Penning (#30) from Lebec, Ca. in third. In an especially tight point race, Kranzler leads Chris Peedan by just a single point. John Penning (#30) of Lebec, Ca. is just two points off the lead.

PRO-4

Pro-4's came out to Speedway Willow Springs on Saturday night to complete a great night of racing. Eddie Secord (#1) took first place, followed by Shawn Steele (#94) and Jodi Davis (#0).

OPEN TESTING

Speedway Willow Springs is available for testing any day we are not racing.

Open testing fees are \$40 per driver and \$10 per crew member. Membership is required. Use your Speedway Willow Springs competition license or purchase a special annual "test only" membership for \$50. Reservations are required. Please call 661-256-6666 to check on availability.

Also, please have your competition license in hand when you sign-in at the Track Office. The Speedway can also be reserved for exclusive rental at \$1,000 per day (8am to 5pm) or \$500 per half-day (AM or PM session).

Note: Speedway competition drivers who purchased a "test only" membership earlier this year, prior to the adoption of the new policy will receive a free open-test day which can be used thru December 31, 2006.

On Saturdays and Sundays, normal \$10 park admission will be charged for everyone. Only drivers need to register with the office. Only drivers who register may drive the course.
